'Uniting Ideas for a Global Future' is the highly relevant theme for the fourth World Maritime Technology Conference (WMTC 2012, www.wmtc2012.org). This international event has the support of Igor Sechin, Vice-Premier of the Russian Federation & Chairman of the Board of the United Shipbuilding Corporation, and the Ministries of the RF, including: Ministry of Industry and Trade, Ministry of Transport, Ministry of Defence, Ministry of Education and Science, Ministry of Economic Development and the Ministry of Natural Resources. The event is also supported by many maritime organisations from all around the world.

Taking place in Saint Petersburg – the maritime capital of the Russian Federation – the event will attract all sectors of the global shipbuilding; marine science, technology and engineering; offshore oil and gas; and naval engineering industries.

WMTC 2012 will be held 29 May – 1 June 2012 at Lenexpo, Saint Petersburg. Will be hosted by NTOS (Science & Technology Society of Shipbuilders of the Russian Federation – named after A.N. This is the triennial event of the World Maritime Technology Congress, previous WMTCs having been held in San Francisco (2003), London (2006) and Mumbai (2009). The prestigious WMTC will provide a valuable forum for experts from many of the different disciplines that make up the maritime industry to share their progress and achievements with their peers in the maritime field and to gain an introduction into the Russian maritime market.
