Call for Poster Presentations

The First World NAOE Forum invites poster presentations to stimulate discussion and exchange ideas on energy-saving and eco-friendly shipping toward 2020. Prizes will be awarded to posters considered to be excellent.

Theme

“Proposals for energy-saving and eco-friendly shipping toward 2020”

Presentation

About 10 posters will be preliminarily selected by the steering committee and exhibited at the forum. Presenters of posters are requested to give a one-minute oral presentation at the morning session from 11:40 to 12:00, and to be present at the lunch and coffee breaks to explain their poster to participants.

Language

Posters, one-minute oral presentations, and on-site explanations should be given in English.

The poster exhibition and explanation will be held in the Senju foyer, and the one-minute oral presentation will be given at Senju in the Senri Hankyu Hotel.

- Poster submission

The digital data of the poster in PDF format and an abstract of about 400 words are to be submitted by 4 November 2011 to the above address. Upon preliminary selection of the posters to be exhibited, notification will be given by 15 November 2011. The poster is to be B1 size (1030 mm high by 728 mm wide), and the file size should be less than 5 MB. The selected posters will be printed by the organizing committee.

Poster award

All the selected posters will be awarded a prize for participation. One best poster prize and two second-best poster prizes will be determined by the vote of participants and awarded to the winners. The criteria for evaluation are (1) originality, (2) concreteness, (3) significance, (4) poster design, and (5) presentation.
